

Program Overview



St. Helena Preschool For All offers opportunities for high-quality early childhood education programs to children in Angwin, Calistoga, & St. Helena communities. Our partnering preschool programs are designed to promote social-emotional, cognitive, and physical development, preparing children for success in kindergarten and beyond.

We currently partner with seven preschools, serving a total of 30 children aged 3-4 years old. Each preschool has highly qualified teachers, who create a warm and welcoming environment where children can learn and grow.

In addition to our preschool programs, we offer a range of family community activities to enhance opportunities for children and their families to connect with the community. These include our Nimbus Arts Holiday Party, St. Helena Public Library special family night, and family swim lessons all free of charge.

This year, we continued to support parent learning through our education classes in partnership with St. Helena Unified School District and the UpValley Family Center as we continue to build a bridge and make the preschool to kindergarten transition a seamless one. In the Calistoga community we are involved in the Calistoga Community School Initiative and participated in the first Early Childhood Resource Fair.

Overall, our programs are designed to promote a love of learning and set children on a path to success in school and in life and give parents the best tools to support them on their journey.

Program Outcomes



At St. Helena Preschool For All, we are committed to ensuring that our programs have a positive impact on the children and families we serve. Here are some program outcomes from 2022:

Children Social-Emotional: SHPFA alumni students demonstrate strong social-emotional development throughout their school career. 99% of alumni are highly optimistic and happy in school and in life and demonstrate positive peer and family relationships.

Parent satisfaction: In a survey conducted at the end of the school year, 98% of parents reported being satisfied or very satisfied with the quality of education and care their child received at our partnering preschools. Parents particularly appreciated the communication and collaboration with teachers, the supportive and inclusive environment, and the opportunity to get to know other families through our program.

Preschool to Kinder Transition: In the St. Helena community we were able to get 100% participation between our 5 local preschools and our TK/Kindergarten teachers to collaborate on the transition from preschool to kindergarten. All 5 preschools shared information for 32 incoming students using an assessment form that focused on "the whole child". It gave the primary school teachers an opportunity to learn about the incoming children, with some of the people that know and care for them the most!



Our organization is also working to increase parent engagement once families become part of the district. This important work is helping to strengthen the relationship between families and the district, and we are proud to support these efforts.



Advancing Our Mission

As a non-profit that provides preschool opportunities and parent supports, our next steps for the future include: sustainability, access & equity, and building community.

1. Sustainability:

- Develop a sustainable fundraising plan that includes both short-term and long-term goals.
- Develop a financial sustainability plan that includes monitoring and managing expenses, identifying cost-saving measures, and establishing a reserve fund.

2. Access & Equity:

- Partnering with community organizations to reach families who may be harder to reach.
- Ensure that your scholarship program is accessible to families of all backgrounds, including those with limited English proficiency or disabilities.
- Expanding our program to serve more families and to offer additional services that can support families.

3. Build Community:

- Develop a strong network of supporters, including families, volunteers, and community leaders.
- Host events and activities that can bring families and supporters together and build a sense of community.
- Develop partnerships with other organizations in our community that share our mission and can support our program in other ways.
- Develop a strong brand and marketing strategy that can help raise awareness about our program and build support for our mission.
